PRACTICAL INFORMATION

Arriving at G. Marconi Airport

Arriving at Bologna airport, participants will find a dedicated **desk for the UNESCO Creative Cities meeting**.

The desk is open on 17th and 18th September from 9am to 7pm. On 17th September the desk will also be open from 10 pm to 10.30 pm.

At the Desk you will receive a **conference kit**, with a "**Bologna Welcome Card**" inside. With this card participants can **travel for free** by bus on the line that connects the airport to the train station and the city center: **BLQ line** (stops: Pontelungo, Ospedale Maggiore, Ugo Bassi, San Pietro, Arena del sole, Central Station). The BLQ bus is available every 15 minutes, starting from 7am to 12:15pm and it takes about half an hour to get to the city center.

With the card you also get free admission to museums and special offers and discounts at restaurants, spas and shops (see the specific brochure that you'll find in the conference kit)

Participants who will not arrive while the desk at the airport is open, will receive the conference kit at the meeting venue.
